PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.	

V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE	
Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523a, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT	
I hereby certify the plumbing work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Plumbing Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the Plumbing Inspector. I will cooperate with the Plumbing Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.	

PLUMBING PERMIT FEE: \$60.00 per inspection (If no work is done in the Township within a year, a \$15.00 administrative fee will be charged.)	\$ _____
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GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**

When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location and permit number.**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and completed. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**

FEE CLARIFICATION:

Item #2, Mobile home unit site: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applications to the Township for a Plumbing Permit shall be in writing signed by the licensee or homeowner(s) of the property and accompanied by a description of the proposed construction/alterations and a statement of the proposed use. The fee shall be paid over the Township Clerk and shall be deposited in the General Fund of the Township.
