MILAN BLIGHT ENFORCEMENT REPORT FOR JUNE 20223

Received 6 complaints of blight or blight conditions in the month of June

13460 Wabash- Running a business and blight junk cars stacked in the yard. An investigation was conducted and the complaint was found. I made contact with the property owner and after a lengthy conversation the property owner was given until the end of July to cease any business activity and remove ALL junk vehicles from the property. Due to the amount of possible oil, transmission fluid, brake fluid, antifreeze on the ground, the EPA was notified and a complaint was filed for possible groundwater contamination. EPA complaint #275403. Received a notice from the EPA that the complaint was forwarded to the State of Michigan on 7/7/23.

9940 AnnArbor rd general blight, scrap, and junk vehicles. A letter was sent 6/23/23. I received a call from the property owner stating that he is trying to get the property clean and removing the non working vehicles. He was instructed that as long as there is work in progress there would be no further action.

I received a call from the property owner and she stated that they will clean up the property but they scrap stuff to make money to live on.
